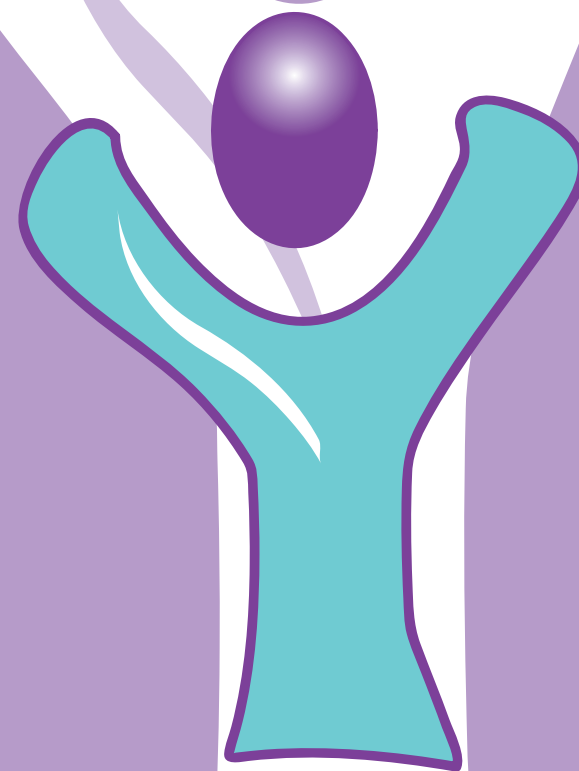

Youth Evaluation and Treatment Centers (YETC) is a 501 (c)3 not for profit agency. Our goal is to nurture our troubled youth back to health, guide them in making better choices, teach them positive behaviors, heal emotional wounds and assist them in leading healthier lives and achieving their personal best.

PROGRAMS & SERVICES

OUTPATIENT

Individual and family centered therapy for youth and their families who are experiencing a range of emotional, behavioral and substance abuse problems. This program consists of a staff of therapists, case managers, family support partners and coordinators.

Services include:

- Child & Family Team Facilitation
- Psychiatric services
- In home and family support
- Respite care
- Behavior coaching
- Case Management
- Individual, group and family therapy
- Multi-family support groups

INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT (IOPSA)

Designed for co-ed youth with substance abuse issues. IOPSA utilizes The Seven Challenges[®] curriculum based on a decision making and empowerment model. Group meets 3 times per week and youth are provided with ongoing individual and family support. Skilled staff address personal, social and family concerns that may contribute to the cycle of addiction.

Services include:

- Education and information on substance abuse issues
- Strength based social and life skills enhancement
- Recovery activities to support a substance free lifestyle
- Development of informal support network

PREVENTION

YETC has teamed up with the Partnership for a Drug Free America, Arizona Affiliate to focus on the reduction of substance abuse and its consequences in Buckeye, AZ. The Way out West Coalition (WOW) was created to build a community partnership that will develop a strategic plan that achieves the aforementioned goal. Please call for more information.

PROJECT NEXT STEP

Family and community centered intervention designed to enhance the stability and integrity of the family by keeping or returning the child to the home. Project Next Step strengthens families, encourages system independence and personal responsibility by creating an individualized plan for each family guided by the CFT. Services are provided in the home and community for children of all ages.

Direct Services include:

- Teaching of parenting skills, conflict resolution, communication skills, collaborative problem solving and independent living skills.
- Non-verbal and verbal crisis intervention techniques (PRT)[®]
- Family support
- Connection to community resources
- Crisis intervention
- Transportation to support service plan
- Functional behavior assessments (FBA's)
- Advocacy
- Education Support
- Assistance in the self administration of medications
- Respite to support community based placement

PNS partners with families, provider network organizations, stakeholders, and the community to provide quality services in a community based and family centered manner.
